

CERTIFICATION & PREPARATORY STUDIES

EAL TEACHER CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

The EALTCP is a University of Winnipeg certificate program for individuals who would like to teach English as an additional language to adults.

This program is offered as an evening program which students can take virtually. In order to receive a certificate, students must complete the following:

- 120 hours of TESL theory and methodology (delivered in an online format)
 - 20 hours of teaching in a practicum
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Practicum Placement involves 10 hours of observation in an experienced EAL teacher's classroom, and 10 hours of supervised teaching in a local EAL classroom.

REQUIRED HIGH SCHOOL COURSES

Applicants need to have graduated from high school. They also need to have completed a minimum of 45 credit hours of university education (or obtain special permission from the Program Director). A completed undergraduate degree is preferred. No specific courses are required.
